Prizes:

Conditions:

- The competition will be played over 18 holes of medal play, in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Club.
 The decision of the Competition Committee will be final.
- 2. The competition is open to male and female amateur golfers who are members of an EGU affiliated golf club. Open to boys with a handicap not exceeding 12 and girls with a handicap not exceeding 18 under the current CONGU Scratch Score and handicapping scheme. The competition will be a qualifying competition for handicapping purposes.
- 3. Competitors must be aged under 18 at 00:00 hrs on 1st January 2013.
- 4. Entries will be limited to 90. In the event of this limit being exceeded, there will be a ballot for places, with a reserve list provided. The Competition Committee reserve the right to refuse entry without reason. ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN MONDAY 15th JULY on the completed entry form below, with a cheque for the entry fee of £35.00 made payable to Brocket Hall International Ltd. Refunds will not be given for withdrawals after the draw has been made.
- 5. In the event of a tie for the trophy the winner will be decided by the standard countback method.
- 6. Practice rounds are permitted weekdays after 14:00 at £30 each and should be booked through the Golf Shop on 01707 368739. All guests must sign the Visitor Book on arrival.
- 7. The entry fee of £35 includes orange juice and bacon roll on arrival and buffet lunch on return to the Clubhouse, prize giving will be at approximately 19:30.
- 8. Competitors are required to report to the relevant starting tees at least 10 minutes prior to their starting time, details of which will be posted to the address on the entry form as soon as possible after the closing date Monday 15th July. Tee times will be between 12:00 and 14:00. The Competition Committee reserves the right to amend any starting times accordingly.
